**Schedule of and Arrangements for the 1<sup>st</sup> Summative Assessments, Year 2012-13**

The 1<sup>st</sup> Summative Assessments of this school year will be held from 7 to 11 January, 2013. The time for coming to school will be as usual. The schedule of the assessments is shown on the attached sheet.

Only those students absent from assessments on medical grounds certified by a medical practitioner may take supplementary assessments.

In order to cater for the varying circumstances, options will be offered to parents regarding the arrangements during the 1<sup>st</sup> Summative Assessment period:

1. You may pick up your child during the following time slots and take him/her home to facilitate his/her revision.

2. You need to show the "**Pick-Up Pass**" for entering the school campus and going to the above location for picking him/her up.
3. If your child normally takes the school bus, and you do not need the school bus service, you are requested to inform the School Bus Team in advance.
4. If you do not wish to pick up your child early, your child can remain on the school campus to do revision under teachers' supervision. Arrangements for lunch and the time of leaving school for your child will remain as usual.

Note: School bus and lunch services will be provided as usual during the assessment period. For those who normally order lunchboxes through the school may choose not to order lunchboxes during the assessment period.
