### **Qualities:**

- Applicants should possess a Master's or Doctoral degree in Educational Psychology from a local university or equivalent qualifications, with at least 6 years of post-degree relevant work experience
- Applicants should have an excellent command of written and spoken Chinese and English
- Experience in serving Direct Subsidy Scheme schools and/or private schools is an advantage
- Able to fulfil the roles and responsibilities listed below

### **Roles and Responsibilities:**

- Provide regular supervision, coaching and crisis management advice to the Educational Psychologists for around 80 to 120 hours per school year
- Provide consultation on school system level, e.g. student support system and policies, crisis management, performance of the Educational Psychology Services Team, etc.
- Provide consultation and training on teacher support level
- Provide consultation on case work and handling of complicated cases
- Provide consultation on professional development, e.g. development of professional skills for individual EPs
- Review documents related to the Educational Psychology Service, such as Annual Work Plan, assessment reports etc.
- Perform other relevant duties as required

- Regular weekly supervision meetings conducted individually or in small groups
